Deadlines	Assignments
By Wednesday May 18th	Email 2 -3 photos for the summer assignments. You can email the photo to Jennifer.campbell@hesperiausd.org . If you are printing it out yourself, make sure the image is 4x6. Each photo must be a close-up of a persons face with a high level of pixels (at least 500x500 pixels) so it doesn't look grainy. I will print it out for you if you need. Think about the composition. Is part of the face going to go off of the side of the paper? Or are you going to go more traditional and have it centered? Make sure you have a good light source.
Monday May 23rd	Go to room C-1 and: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Give me your email address (the one you will be checking over the summer) 2. Pick up supplies to complete the projects: your two reference photos (if you need help with formatting let me know), 2-3 sheets of paper for chalk, one white charcoal pencil, one black charcoal pencil, and a box of chalk. Make sure all of the colors are in the box. 3. The reference photo will be printed out 4x6. You will make it 3 times the size so your final artwork will be 12x18 (not as big as the entire paper)

By July 1st Out of 100pts	Take a photo of your first completed summer assignment and upload it and the original onto the class webpage. If you are ever asked for a password, it will be the word: secret. Save your jpeg image of the original and the drawing to your desktop. Go to Campbellsartclass.weebly.com then click on the "Art 2, 3, 4 & AP" tab, then click on "Ap Summer Assignment," then click on the link that says "click on this link and post summer assignment #1." Shrink the window and drag your image from the desktop and drop it onto this page. Make sure you put both the original image and a photo of your drawing onto the page. Don't forget to type your name onto your artwork. Your artwork will be graded based on the level of quality. By July 5th Out of 25pts	Comment on the artwork of 5 other students in the Summer Assignment #1 forum (the same place you uploaded your images). If one student already has 5 comments, then please comment on the student that only has a few. Please give your criticism constructively. Tell the students how their artwork can be improved. Grading

You will be graded on the quality of your artworks and the comments you post. Each artwork is worth 100pts. They must be of high quality. You are welcome to do a 3rd or 4th artwork of your choice in order to free up more time during the school year. You will also be graded based on your participation within the posts. You will be given 25 points for posting 5 quality posts in the 1st summer assignment category and 25 points for posting 5 quality posts in the 2nd summer assignment category. Remember 5 of your posts in each category must contain something valuable. You must describe what can be improved and how they could make that happen. You can post things like good job and etc. as long as it is beyond your 5 required valuable posts in each category.
